



ARENA/PARKS OPERATOR

The Town of Calmar requires a permanent full-time Arena/Parks Operator starting the week of 16 September 2019.

The successful candidate will assist in day to day operations and maintenance of the Mike Karbonik Arena from mid-September to March and then assist in the maintenance of parks, playgrounds, and sport fields from April to September. In addition, the successful candidate will also assist other departments with other duties when required.

The successful candidate must be comfortable working with the general public and demonstrate excellent 'people' skills and must be willing to work evenings and weekends (primarily) during the ice season and participate in the Rotational On-Call.

Previous experience, Arena Operator Certification, and Sports Field Certification are all considered assets. **Candidates to be interviewed MUST present current Criminal Records Check (issued within the past 6 months) and Driver's Abstract at time of interview.**
