Business Unit Information:

To provide five safe, quality indoor ice surfaces to Airdrie citizens, for the purposes of recreation, wellness, and local organized sport.

Primary Accountabilities Include:

We are looking to fill future positions for the Seasonal Arena Operators, starting October 2017 to May 2018.

This is a part-time (primarily evenings and weekends), Arena Operator position reporting to the Operations Coordinator. This job posting is open to experienced as well as entry level Operators. The ideal candidate will have a working knowledge of arena operations.

As part of a team, the candidate will ensure assigned duties and customer service will be attended to in an efficient manner. In this team environment the candidate will promote positive relations with staff and customers alike. Additionally, the Arena Operator will play a lead role in emergency situations, as the first point of contact with the public and emergency responders.

Accountable for cleanliness of glass partitions, washrooms, dressing rooms, official's rooms, player boxes, penalty boxes and public areas within the facility
Regular ice making with an electric ice resurfer and power edger
Maintaining written logs on a per-shift basis is required.

Education/Experience Requirements:

Some experience working in an ice hockey environment, including working knowledge of ice making equipment, would be required
Current Standard First Aid Level C CPR and AED certification is required (provide copy with application)
A valid Class 5 Driver's License is required
AARFP Arena Operator certification (level 1 and/or 2) would be an asset (provide copy with application)

Working knowledge of ice making equipment
A keen awareness for working safely
Ability to communicate effectively and offer excellent customer service to visitors and staff
Enjoy being part of a team striving to excel in their delivery of exceptional facilities and service to the citizens of Airdrie

Additional Information:

This seasonal position will run from October 2017 to May 2018.

This is an evening and weekend position, some shifts involving late nights. Arena Operators will be expected to commit to a minimum of an eight (8) hour shift at least once per bi-weekly pay period.

Candidates must be able to perform physically demanding tasks and will regularly be required to lift, bend and kneel. Operators will work in varying temperatures and environmental conditions.

Successful candidates to this position will be required to provide an acceptable drivers abstract.

Interviewing and hiring may commence prior to the posted closing date.

The successful applicant will be required to complete a current, acceptable Criminal Records Check, including Vulnerable Sector, upon hire.
