- ISA certification
- A minimum of three (3) years' experience in the tasks and equipment relating to a Parks environment,
- Completion of coursework or certification in safety management is an asset,
- Completion of coursework or certification in areas of leadership, teamwork or supervision,
- Experience in a municipal setting is an asset,

- Valid Alberta Class 3Q Motor vehicle operator's licence is an asset (drivers abstract is required),
- Sufficient physical strength and dexterity to perform manual labour for extended periods of time under various weather conditions.
