Community Services, Parks and Recreation** – we are recruiting for **11** summer positions who will do manual labour for maintenance and operations in the Parks and Recreation system, these positions will commence the end of April and conclude the end of August. We will also have **2** summer positions that will begin at the end of April and conclude at the end of October 2018. The CUPE 2018 salary ranges for these positions are \$20.05 – \$22.82 per hour;
