As one of our Spray Park and Wading Pool Attendants, you oversee the day to day mechanical operation, administration and maintenance of the very busy spray decks and wading pools we operate.

### Responsibilities:

- Act immediately and appropriately to ensure safety of customers in the event of an emergency
- Provide emergency care and treatment as required until arrival of emergency medical services
- Present a professional appearance and attitude at all times, including wearing the provided uniform during each shift and appropriate footwear
- Enforcement of the rules and regulations of the facility
- Maintaining an excellent standard of customer engagement
- Ensuring the facilities are clean and safe by performing daily maintenance tasks and doing frequent checks
- Enforce patron compliance for all health and safety regulations, including those instated to prevent the spread of COVID-19
- Overseeing the operation of the aquatic system, including balancing chemicals, performing filter cleanses, and doing water tests
- Compiling daily data such as water tests and head counts in a neat and orderly fashion
- Complete and submit administrative reports, such as First Aid, Incident, or Aquatic Wheelchair Forms
- Perform monthly work site and hazard inspections
- Maintain required certifications, and recertifying at employee's expense if necessary (with the exception of Pool Operator, TDG and WHMIS certifications).

You are responsible for water quality, mechanical functions and for ensuring the facility and surrounding area is safe, clean and aesthetically pleasing. You ensure that visitors to the facility have a safe and enjoyable experience. You are comfortable interacting with people and especially with children, spotting problems quickly and dealing with them effectively.

### Qualifications required:

- Standard First Aid (awarded after September 2019)
- CPR-C/AED (Awarded after September 2020)
- Ability to provide a clean City of Calgary Police Information Check

- WHMIS and TDG certification

**Salary Range:** \$17.00 - \$19.00 per hour depending on qualifications.

#### **Health and Safety:**

- While performing the essential functions of this job, some tasks involve the ability to exert very moderate physical effort, typically involving some combination of standing, standing at a height, sitting, crouching, walking, climbing, performing work while wet and/or performing the aforementioned tasks for extended periods of time.
- Safe lifting, bending, and carrying techniques are required.
- Use of appropriate PPE (provided by Benchmark) when dealing with any and all pool chemicals, as well as certain cleaning products.
- Ability to bend, push, pull, lift and walk as pool operator to modify filter settings, move chemicals, distribute chemicals in the pool and to clean filters.
- In efforts to prevent the spread of COVID-19, all precautions will be taken to disinfect facilities and protect both patrons and employees from possible spread
