Are you a "night owl" looking to make some extra cash working in the late hours of the night and into the early hours of the morning? Consider this opportunity!

As a **Swimming Pool Service Worker**, you will be responsible for maintaining the overall cleanliness of the Leisure Centre. Please note most work is completed alone during your shift.

Duties include:

- Performing general janitorial work which involves washing floors, walls, windows, fixtures; vacuuming the pool and carpeted areas; and ensuring the washrooms are clean and tidy
- Filtration maintenance
- Taking periodic scheduled readings of the pools chemical balance
- Balancing water chemistry
- Reporting any security problems
- Performing minor repairs
- Lifting of objects up to 20 kg is required as part of the normal duties
- Related duties as required

Qualifications:

- Completion Grade 10
- Minimal swimming ability (able to swim at least one length of a pool)
- Ability to understand and execute verbal and written instructions along with a working knowledge of computers
- Use of respiratory protection including Self Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) is required for some duties included in this position. Compliance with the City of Edmonton's Code of Practice for Respiratory Protective Equipment, including medical monitoring is a requirement for these positions
- Standard First Aid, CPR and AED certificates are a condition of employment. Successful candidates will be required to obtain these certifications upon commencing in the position
- Experience cleaning an aquatic environment is an asset
- Ability to acquire knowledge of the standard methods, material and equipment employed in the care and maintenance of swimming pools and related facilities
- Good decision making, prioritization, and time management skills
- An original Police Information Check, including Vulnerable Sector Check issued within the past 6 months that is satisfactory to the employer will be required before starting in the position. The new hire will be required to obtain this check from Edmonton Police Service. Please note, this may take up to 3 weeks to process

Hours of Work: Up to 60 biweekly, Monday - Sunday. Typical hours of work start late in the evening and end in the early morning

Salary Range: 10M, Salary Grade: 063, \$17.327 - \$24.025 (Hourly), \$1,386.16 - \$1,922.00 (Biweekly). The rates quoted are in accordance with a collective agreement between the Union and the City of Edmonton. This Union contract is currently under negotiation
