The City of Dawson Creek invites applications for one permanent part time Lifeguard 1 position term (until August 31, 2019) at the Kenn Borek Aquatic Centre. There will be minimum twenty five hours of work guaranteed weekly and shifts will be scheduled to meet operational requirements. Under the general supervision of the Aquatics Coordinator or designate, a lifeguard/instructor performs life guarding and instructing functions at the swimming pool as well as minor maintenance.

The successful applicants must demonstrate ability and possess the following current qualifications:

- Current National Lifeguard Award (Pool Option);
- Current Red Cross Water Safety Instructor Certification;
- Current Standard First Aid;
- Current CPR Level C & AED Certification - to be recertified every six months.
- One year (or minimum 528 hrs.) guarding experience.

The successful applicant will be required to complete and submit a Criminal Record Search, the results of which must be satisfactory to the City. Along with a demonstrated teaching and leadership ability, the successful applicant will have the ability to perform all duties in a safe manner and to maintain harmonious relationships with all members of the public and other staff members. Physical agility, the ability to complete duties requiring physical effort and a proven ability to provide excellent service to the public are required.
