Function/Purpose:

Educate pool patrons regarding pool safety, prevent unsafe activities or behaviors, intervene and provide rescue assistance for patrons in difficulty or distress. Administer first aid as required. Clean the swimming pool and area ensuring that conditions are sanitary at all times. Lifeguard and instruct classes alone, act as "Lead Hand" in the delivery of learn to swim lessons. Provide Public with program and schedule information. Provide input into program schedules. Staff and supervise pool promotions.

Job Requirements:

- Grade 10 or equivalent. (18 years of age)
- Possession of current National Lifeguard Service Certificate, Standard First Aid Certification, CPR Basic Rescuer, Red Cross Water Safety Instructor, Lifesaving Instructors, Aquatic Fitness Instructor
- Lifeguarding experience.
- Ability to handle public relations responsibilities effectively and thoroughly and to be firm and tactful in maintaining pool discipline and to respond calmly to emergencies.
- Ability to maintain continuous alertness and attention when lifeguarding.
- Ability to communicate effectively with all patron, lifeguards and instructors.
- Ability to provide leadership for lifeguard/instructor staff. Provide leadership in re-certification and in-service training events.
- Ability to provide a high level of accuracy during rescue procedures.
- Ability to exert physical effort demanded by swimming, pulling patrons from the water, cleaning, and outdoor tarp pulling.
- Ability to work in full view of the public, and stand for long periods of time.
- Ability to work in conditions which may be noisy and mildly unpleasant (when using disinfectant and cleaning up after patron's sickness).
- Ability to meet physical standard as required by the National Lifeguard Service Award.
- Ability to attend mandatory lifeguard in-service training sessions.
- Possess effective verbal and written skills.
- Ability to work shifts.
