Physical Requirements and Safety:

- **While performing the essential functions of this job, some tasks involve the ability to exert very moderate physical effort, typically involving some combination of standing, standing at a height, sitting, sitting at a height, crouching, walking, climbing, swimming, performing work while wet and/or performing the aforementioned tasks for extended periods of time. Must be able to lift a minimum of 30 LBS when required.**
- **Emergency tasks and regular staff training events involve the performance of physically demanding work, which may involve some combination of running, climbing and/or swimming and may involve lifting, carrying, pushing and/or pulling heavy objects including distressed persons on land or in the water, including performing work while wet and/or performing the above tasks for extended periods of time.**
- **Safe lifting, bending, carrying and rescue techniques and the use of a rescue aid in the water and the coordination of rescue with a second rescuer and rescue aids in the water, when possible, are required. The successful candidate will be required to complete a Technical skills assessment portion of the Recruitment process; this includes but is not limited to: Refresher of NL standards, timed swim, brick carry, and Lesson Plan development and execution.**
