**POSITION: Senior Lifeguard-Instructor**

**Position Duties:**

- Instructs and lifeguards aquatic programs in a professional manner
- Competent and skilled in emergency response procedures and providing first aid.
- Completes daily pool operations, maintenance and chemical checks
- Reports any deficiencies or safety concerns to Aquatics Supervisor
- Assists with routine maintenance and daily cleanliness providing a clean and safe environment for all patrons
- Enforces pool rules and Alberta health regulations with patrons using the pool
- Provides leadership to other staff and mentors junior lifeguards
- Make sound decisions regarding patron usage with safety as the main concern when issues arise
- Assists with public education, outreach strategies and promotion of aquatic programs and services as required.
- Must actively participate in all “in-service” training.
- Act as a shift leader when assigned by Aquatics Supervisor.
- Actively participate in Formal Workplace Inspections in area of responsibility
- Review pertinent Hazard Identification, Assessment and Control worksheets on an annual basis as required by the Municipal Health and Safety Program
- Follow all Safe Work Practices and Procedures
- Immediately report any unsafe conditions, potential work hazards or incidents to Supervisor
- Perform other related duties as directed by supervisor.
