Come work in a new state of the art Aquatic Facility in Barrhead, Alberta. We are looking for two full time Head guard staff members. The pool consists of a 25m 6 lane pool, a fabulous zero depth entry leisure pool with a tot splash area and a lazy river, a hot tub, and a steam room. The facility is attached to the Agrena and the curling rink in Barrhead. Reporting to the Aquatic Coordinator the Head Guard is responsible for opening/closing of the facility, provide great public relations, complete water tests and water samples, supervise staff, participate in staff In-services once a month, supervise pools, teach swimming lessons, Aqua fitness and hydro-rider classes. Step in and cover shifts when needed, evaluate aquatic programs and staff, help clean and coordinate the daily work of lifeguards and instructors, ensure a safe and fun aquatic experience for public, other duties as assigned. Excellent team building and mentoring skills, ensure a safe and fun environment for all staff, volunteers and public, ensure all staff are ready on deck and prepared when their shifts starts. This position will also include working with filtration systems, water balancing and chemical addition on chlorinated pools. Work with mechanical issues within the aquatics centre, refer bigger issues to maintenance.
