Position Summary

Reporting to the Coordinator, Aquatic Operations, the Lifeguard III is responsible for ensuring the safety for patrons of the Manluk Center, located in the City of Wetaskiwin. The Aquatic center features a Lazy River, Competition Pool, hot tub, steam room, waterslides and Canada's only Board Rider Surf Feature along with fitness and multi-purpose fitness rooms.

The Lifeguard III is a full time permanent position (35-40 hours per week) and is responsible for ensuring the safety of patrons by preventing injuries through public education, providing first aid and completing maintenance and administration tasks.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Performs all duties and responsibilities of a Lifeguard Level III as required
- Responds to and supervises emergency situations, performs first aid as required and ensures that required documentation is completed
- Water tests
- Assists in observing and evaluating lifeguard techniques of junior lifeguard staff
- Prevent injuries by providing public education and administering first aid treatment and/or emergency response is required
- Ensure a clean and safe facility for patrons by completing daily maintenance tasks
- Sets up and takes down equipment according to the facility schedule
- Conducts routine safety inspections
- Ability to enforce all health and safety rules and regulations as required
- Provide excellent customer service to patrons

- Must have a minimum of 3 years of experience working in an aquatic facility and have 1 year experience supervising junior lifeguards.

- Aquatic Emergency Care (AEC) and/or Standard First Aid (SFA) with CPR Level C & AED
- Water Safety Instructor (WSI)

- Lifesaving Instructor (LSI)
