NATIONAL ARENA CENSUS

The Canadian Recreation Facilities Council's Provincial/Territorial member Associations, Natural Resources Canada, Sport Canada and Hockey Canada are in the process of conducting a National Arena Census. This census will allow us to update the existing arena information in our database and to provide a clear picture of the state and needs of arena infrastructure across the country.

Surveys were mailed to every facility in Canada during the month of June. These surveys have been coming in at a steady rate during July and August and it is anticipated that this project will be completed by October 31, 2005.

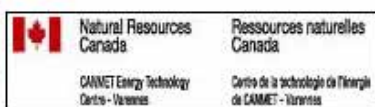
