

Managing Liability Risks For Pools and Recreation Facilities

In 2017 the University of Regina was found to be liable for \$9.1 million in damages as a result of a diving incident. The university argued during the trial that the pool had been rented to a swim club and depth and the height of the starting blocks met Swimming Canada guidelines. The decision highlights the importance of sound risk management policies and practices in all recreational facilities. Pools, gymnasiums and arenas should all be aware of lessons learned in this case.

To assist in this regard, we developed this workshop.

The session will provide information on the Regina case as well as a number of other relevant cases stemming from a variety of recreation facilities and most importantly we will be providing information necessary to ensure that such losses don't take place in your department.
