The successful candidate will possess a high school diploma, or equivalent, with a minimum of three years of experience working in building maintenance or building mechanical; experience with recreation facilities is preferred. A Class 5 driver's licence, aerial work platform operator ticket, fall arrest and restraint certification and Standard First Aid and WHMIS are required. Building maintenance 1 and 2 certificates would be assets. Must have the ability to work flexible shifts, evenings and weekends and participate in the on-call rotation as required. Weekend shift is Thursday through Monday with Tuesday and Wednesday as days off. The successful candidate must be willing to obtain and maintain a RCMP Enhanced Level Security Clearance.
