Aquatic Team Leader

Recreation opportunities are available in several different facilities: a Sports Complex, Skate Park, Aquatic Centre, Splash Park, Off Leash Dog Park, and 350 acres of green spaces, the Town of Olds is a great place for recreation.

The Town of Olds has an opening for a full time Aquatic Team Leader position in the Community Services Department. Reporting to the Supervisor – Aquatic Centre, the incumbent will contribute to providing overall leadership to Olds Aquatic Centre staff. The incumbent will perform lifeguard duties, pool maintenance, supervise and schedule staff, aquatics programs development and implementation for the community and provide customer service to the patrons of the Olds Aquatics Centre and the Olds Splash Park. During the summer, this position is also responsible for the daily balancing of the water quality and mechanical checks of the Olds Splash Park. The Team Leader also may play a key role in the fall maintenance shut down.

- Red Cross Water Safety Instructor
- Standard First Aid/CPRC/AED
- Class 5 Alberta Driver's license
- Three-year aquatics supervisory experience in a municipal environment

- Pool Operator 1 & 2
- Lifesaving Instructor/Trainer

Compensation is based on a 40-hour work week. The position requires rotational weekend, day, and evening shifts.
