- Current certifications in National Lifeguard Certification, Standard First Aid with CPR C, Water Safety Instructor
- Proficient swimming ability

- Recognize and identify swimmers in distress or in the process of unsafe behaviors
- Standing for long periods of time
- Instruct swim lessons in the water, instructor maybe wet for an extended period of time
- Frequently required to sit at a height, kneel, stand, crouch, walking, climbing, swimming, reach, and perform work while wet and/or perform work while wet for extended period of time
- As per provincial regulations, minimum lifeguard hiring age will be 16 years
- Varying shifts: morning, daytime, evenings, weekends, split shifts
